LOVE 101 FM Partnership: Letter from the GM (Presented in part)

Hi Dr. Davidson,

I hope you are well and that your house is intact post Sandy. I have been meaning to send this email for quite a while now and had a bout of conscience when I had an unrelated chat with Kitty Roberts last night.

I just wanted to indicate that Family Time is beginning to have the effect that we were hoping for as the numbers in the segment (5:30 pm Thursday) have definitely grown compared with the outcome of the survey conducted in 2009 prior to the placement of Family Time in that slot.

The 2012 survey shows an audience that starts at 57,000 at 5:30 pm tying with Zip fm for second place behind RJR which has 63,000 listeners at that time. By 6:00 pm we drop to 40,000 listeners, putting us in 4th place behind RJR – 51,000 and Hitz and Irie both with 46,000.

I think we had shared with you that our vision was to compete for the evening drive time listeners not just to gain the audience share (which of course we want!) but because of the impact we can have as so many people commuting home are heading into dysfunctional families, broken marriages untenable relationships with children etc.

In that regard I think the programme is beginning to fulfill its purpose and we are quite pleased.

I hope this helps as we continue to work together to make Family Time the best that it can be.
