This 198 page book is easy to read and down to earth yet scholarly reflecting the authors' qualifications and experiences. The purpose of this book is to prepare parents and the extended family with authentic parenting skills and to provide information relative to raising children to become productive citizens. The Bibliography reflects a wide cross

section of renowned authors and publishers.

The book is structured in thirteen (13) chapter divisions that work through progressive stages with age appropriate information for the first time parents to the parents of teenagers. The themes discussed address critical and important issues that relate to good parenting. Wayne's Parenting Jips

Do:

- Spend quality time with your children (do things together, speak with them often, take time to listen to them, help them with their schoolwork
- Pray for them and pronounce blessings over them
- Raise them in the fear of The Lord (teach them to pray, have regular prayer and bible reading at home)
- Hug them, express love and affection physically as well as verbally.
- Discipline them in love
- Encourage and motivate them
- Live by example and love each other as spouses
- Try to be mindful of the various needs of your family members (Phil. 2: 4)

Don't:

- Tear them down, or criticize them harshly
- Physically abuse or discipline with no love
- If more than one child, do not compare one to the other
- Overindulge or spoil them
